

How Globalism, Terrorism, Mammonism, and Socialism Are Changing the Face of World Missions in these End Times

Firstly, I want to thank Arno Froese for inviting me to participate in this year's Prophecy Conference and to speak to you about a subject that is near and dear to my heart...World Missions. More specifically, given the perilous times that we are living in, I want to talk with you about "How Globalism, Terrorism, Mammonism, and Socialism are changing the face of World Missions in these End-Times." However, before I do so I need to give you a little background on how World Missions began in the Americas.

My ancestors were one of the earliest missionary couples sent out by Count Zinzendorf from Herrnhut, Germany in 1739 to bring the Gospel to the natives in Suriname, South America, formerly called Dutch Guiana. To get to their field assignment they had to travel over 7500 miles. First they traveled 800-miles by horse and wagon from Herrnhut, Germany, located southeast of Dresden on the Polish border, to Amsterdam, Holland. Then in Amsterdam they boarded a ship that took them another 4,000 miles to Philadelphia, PA, one of the 13 original British Colonies in the Americas. They then traveled 100-miles by covered wagon through dangerous Indian Territory to Bethlehem, PA where they rested from their long journey at the Moravian Mission until the next merchant ship sailed from Philadelphia to Suriname, S.A. All in all, it took my ancestors over one-year to make the journey from Germany to Suriname, which they did periodically during their 23-year missionary careers until the death of Heinrich Beutel/Beitel at the age of 46, probably from malaria, at a Wednesday night worship service in Herrnhut.

It is hard for us today to imagine the physical hardships and dangers my ancestors experienced, almost 40-years before the American Revolution, to bring the Gospel to heathen Indians in the jungles of South America to fulfill the Great Commission given to us by Christ Himself. And they were not alone, because history tells us that many of God's people from the early "pietistic" movement of the early 1700s in Europe made similar journeys all over the known world to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

My wife and I have visited the archives in Herrnhut, Germany and in Bethlehem, PA and have obtained copies of all my ancestor's letters written from Suriname. While visiting those archives we also learned that during those early days in Bethlehem, PA the Indians, harsh winters, famine, and disease killed almost the entire population at the Moravian Mission there. Nevertheless, new missionaries from Europe continued to heed the call of the Holy Spirit to come to the Americas to make Disciples of Christ! This method of spreading the Gospel around the world eventually became known as the "Modern Missionary Movement."

How many of us here today would have been willing to make the same sacrifices those early missionaries made to bring the Gospel to the Americas? Not many, I'm afraid! But thank God some did, and we should all be thankful for our Christian heritage that is under serious attack in the US today, but that is not the topic of my presentation today! What I do want to talk about, however, is how Globalism, Terrorism, Mammonism, and Socialism are changing the face of world missions in these End-Times.

Globalism's Effect on Missions

We often hear today about how globalism is affecting the world's economies, but rarely do we think or talk about its effect on World Missions. However, before we can discuss the affects of globalization on World Missions we must first understand what globalization is. Globalization

describes an ongoing process by which regional economies, societies, and cultures become integrated through a “global network of exchange.” The term is often used to refer specifically to economic globalization: the integration of national economies into the international economy through trade, foreign direct investment, capital flows, migration, and the spread of technology.

That said however, globalization is usually recognized as being driven by a combination of economic, technological, socio-political, cultural, and biological factors. But the term can also refer to the “transnational dissemination of ideas, languages, or popular culture.” **For the purposes of my presentation this afternoon, I will use the term “globalization” to refer to the spread of technology around the world and its affects on World Missions.**

Today we can travel the same distance my ancestors did in 1739 in less than a day! It is simply amazing what technology has done to change the way we live and work! Presently missionaries can travel from their home in the US to their field assignment as fast and as often as necessary, so long as they have the money to do so. And many missionary families do just that whenever serious life-threatening issues or important family matters arise. This was simply not physically possible in earlier times!

But that is not the only benefit of globalism in our times! Some mission organizations today are specifically organized to take advantage of this phenomenon. They are specifically structured to send “specially trained staff” to foreign countries on month-long or more visits several times a year to conduct seminars designed to teach national pastors and lay people biblical theology, discipleship and evangelism techniques, and church planting methods, so they in turn can teach and train other nationals to do the same.

This “multiplication” method of spreading the Gospel and church planting began about 20-years ago and is quite different from the “modern” missionary method described earlier, where individual missionaries and their families went to live and serve in foreign countries for long periods of time returning home on furlough only once every 4-years or longer.

That is however, only one example of how “technological” globalization has changed the way churches and missionary organizations spread the Gospel around the world! In fact, technological developments in modern transportation were only responsible for one small aspect of the “worldwide” globalization movement that has taken place! **The “communication revolution,” that also began about the same time, I believe was a more determining factor!** Improvements in computer technology, coupled with the development and growth of the Internet, and the high-speed telecommunications industry has revolutionized our ability to communicate instantaneously with just about anyone around the world.

What used to take years, months, and then weeks to do via the now antiquated worldwide postal system can now be accomplished in just minutes or seconds by telephone, fax, or over the Internet! And because the cost of these new communication tools continues to drop yearly, they are now financially available to almost everyone in the world, rich and poor alike! In his book “The World is Flat” Thomas L. Friedman says the communication revolution of the last 25-years has enabled people of all cultures and from every economic level to have access to the world’s knowledge and to effectively compete in the world marketplace.

Globalization in communications has changed the face of World Missions more than most Christians, churches, and mission organizations realize. In fact, the emergence of instantaneous, global communications is responsible for a new “paradigm” that I believe will change the way churches and organizations conduct World Missions in the future! This new paradigm has been made possible by the convergence of satellite, Internet, and telephone technologies enabling people and organizations worldwide to communicate with each other

instantaneously any time day or night. Mankind is no longer limited by time or distance today, but can easily communicate around the world by cell phone, satellite, or computer located in the home, workplace, or even while sitting in a roadside cafe.

It was not that long ago, perhaps 60-years, when most people living in rural America had to be satisfied with a two or three-party telephone line controlled by a local operator who physically connected one telephone line to another, who could then listen in on your conversation, and even disconnect you if you spoke too long. Back then no one complained about the lack of telephone privacy because its convenience far outweighed any other alternative at that time. Besides, a multiple-party line guaranteed people living in small communities some degree of social interaction and even security when local disasters struck!

However, those “good ole days” are gone forever, replaced by “hand-held” communication devices first imagined by the creators of the Dick Tracey comic strip back in the ‘50s. Today one can hardly travel to a country where its citizens do not have personal cell phones, access to the Internet, and satellite TV and radio in their homes...even in the poorest countries! I was shocked when traveling in the Middle East in 1998 to see just how many poor people used cell phones and had satellite dishes on their homes.

The US is far behind the rest of the world when it comes to the use of satellite technology to transmit TV, radio, and Internet signals into the home. The reason for this is quite simple: because satellite companies outside the US do not charge a “monthly fee” for the consumer to receive their satellite TV and radio signals. The consumer need only invest \$150 to purchase a satellite dish and receiver! As a result, around the world satellite has become the primary method for receiving TV and radio signals in the home! And some people are predicting that satellite will eventually replace land-based cable and telephone systems here in the US.

Let me share with you one personal experience of how the communication revolution has impacted World Missions. My wife and I went to Germany in 1994 to start the first Christian FM radio station in Europe. However, after we arrived we quickly learned that high salaries and related employment benefits like 30-days paid vacations, 14 paid holidays, and unlimited sick days, would financially prevent us from starting a “live” Christian radio station that broadcasts 24/7, as most stations do in the US. At the time, we concluded that it would be foolish and presumptuous to think that a non-commercial, faith-operated Christian radio station in Germany could raise \$1.5 Million annually from listeners to operate a local FM station in a culture where less than 3% of the population were born-again believers. **And time has proven us correct!**

We didn’t realize then that our Sovereign Lord had a better plan for us and RADIO New Hope, nor did we know that His plan would not materialize until 10-years later when in 2004 we received our first satellite radio license to broadcast 24/7 over ASTRA, Europe’s largest satellite provider. It was only then that we realized that during all those years we were waiting on the Lord to accomplish our vision for Christian radio in Germany, He was busy bringing satellite, computer, and telephone technologies together **so that He could bless us with a satellite radio station capable of reaching all of Europe, and not just Germany!**

As is the case with most believers, our vision for ministry is often much smaller than what the Lord has in mind! **Today, RADIO New Hope can be heard in 42-countries throughout Europe,** and not just within a 50-mile radius in Germany that would have been the case had we pursued our plans for a local FM frequency. Had we not been patient and trusting in Him to provide the best solution to accomplish our vision for Christian radio in Europe, **RADIO New Hope would probably not exist today!**

But that was not the only benefit of our “waiting on the Lord!” As a result of getting a satellite radio license, RNH had the opportunity to pioneer a new radio transmission concept that our satellite provider was then developing. Instead of transmitting our radio signal from a tower, as FM radio stations did back then, RNH transmits its radio signal to the satellite company over the Internet using a dedicated IP line. The satellite provider then extracts our signal off our Internet stream and converts it to the satellite frequency for transmission over its system.

This new radio signal transmission technique reduced our annual operating expenses by 80%! Instead of costing \$1.5 Million annually to operate Radio New Hope, the Lord’s solution reduced our annual budget to only \$300,000 a year...20% of what we originally forecast back in 1994!

To realize those operating savings, however, required that we simultaneously broadcast our radio signal over the Internet, and this had the affect of expanding our station’s evangelistic outreach to include web listeners all over the world! That is the kind of miracle believers can expect when they patiently wait on the Lord to workout the “best” solution to a problem involving His Work. And in our case that meant waiting 10-years! But as a result of waiting on the Lord, RADIO New Hope is able to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ in over 97-Million households throughout Europe!

No secular or Christian radio station in the US reaches as many households as RNH does, and that was only made possible by the “communication revolution” I have been describing. **In 2007 RNH received its second satellite radio license and in January 2008 began broadcasting God’s Word into 47.5-Mllion households throughout the Middle East, including northern Africa, Turkey, Iraq, and Iran.**

Dear Friends, as a result of “globalization in communications” it is now possible for RNH to proclaim the Gospel throughout the “whole world” by satellite and Internet radio! For the first time since Jesus commanded His disciples to proclaim the Gospel “to all nations and peoples” in Matt. 28:18-20 almost 2,000-years ago, it is now physically possible for believers to do so! Last year RNH was offered the opportunity to lease radio frequencies on satellites all over the world, **and the only thing that is keeping RNH from accomplishing Christ’s commandment is MONEY!**

As I said moments ago, the cost of launching a new RNH satellite and Internet radio station is \$300,000 a year, about what it costs today to send 4 missionaries into the field! Now how many full-time missionaries do you think it would take to proclaim the Gospel “to all the people” in just the 42-countries in Europe and the Middle East currently receiving our satellite-radio broadcasts? **Thousands would be my guess!**

I am presently raising funds in the US to launch 2 new satellite and Internet radio stations: one covering all of India with over 1-billion potential listeners and a second station covering all of Russia and the Caucuses. **Imagine being able to proclaim the Gospel throughout those vast regions with only two satellite radio stations...that’s a miracle!**

We are seeking to partner with churches, mission organizations, and individual believers who appreciate the great potential that RNH has been given by the Lord:

- To evangelize vast regions of the “unsaved” world with the Word of God;
- To theologically train native pastors and lay people so they can train others; and
- To teach nationals the biblical principles and techniques of church planting.

We are also searching for sources of biblically sound programming in all the different dialects for the proposed Indian and Russian radio stations. If you or your church would like to be a part of this exciting world mission opportunity see me during the remainder of this Conference for details.

Why is this important now?

1. Perhaps you've heard that in India Christian churches, orphanages, and health facilities started and financed by Christian churches and mission organizations in the US are being burned down on a regular basis and their staff attacked and killed by Hindu and Buddhist fanatics seeking to destroy any Christian influence in their region.
2. In August 2009 homes of 12 Christians in Pakistan were torched and burned by rioting Muslims resulting in the death of 8-people including 4-women and a child because of unsubstantiated allegations that some Christian had desecrated the Koran.
3. As I speak, missionaries in Russia and its former Soviet Republics in the Caucasus are being forced to return home by visa authorities that are making it impossible for them to stay and minister there. President Putin and his puppet governments in the Caucasus have changed their visa laws limiting foreign visitors to a 3-month stay and then requiring them to leave the country for 3-months before they can apply for a return visa. This change makes it physically impossible for long-term missionaries and their families to live and serve in those countries. And practically speaking, it has also made it impossible for their mission agencies to properly staff their field offices in the region as well.
4. Now that the 2008 Summer Olympics are over and the western world has become dependent on China's fast-growing economy to keep their own economies healthy, the Chinese authorities are using their newfound economic leverage to crack down on Christian mission and aid organizations and forcing them to leave the country. Like Russia, China was willing to tolerate Christian mission and aid organizations in their country so long as they needed western investment and technology to bring their nations out of the dark ages. And now that they have succeeded, western countries are in no position to put economic pressure on them to do otherwise.
5. In the Middle East, prior to 9-11-2001, US mission and aid organizations operated openly throughout the region as long as their staff did nothing to draw attention to themselves and their mission activities. However, after President Bush announced the "US War on Terrorism" and began striking back against Muslim nations that trained, financed, or harbored terrorists, it became more and more dangerous for American missionaries to live and serve there. Today it is practically impossible for western missionaries to obtain visas to live and operate in the Middle East, or in any predominately Muslim nation. Since the "War on Terrorism," western missionaries have become the "primary" targets of the terrorists. As I mentioned earlier, western missionaries and aid workers are being killed almost daily, or kidnapped, abused, and ransomed for money to pay for terrorist activities.

The Result of Terrorism in the 10-40 Window

As a result of the growth of religious terrorism throughout the Muslim world, known in mission circles as the "10-40 Window," it has become a very sensitive issue for churches and mission organizations to send western missionaries into the region. As a result, mission organizations that have operated in those countries for the last 20-years are now frantically trying to come up

with other methods of meeting the spiritually needs of nationals in the region they have devoted so much time, energy, and money to evangelize, train, and disciple.

When the 10-40 Window first opened in 1989, experienced mission leaders knew then that it would not remain open forever! Regardless, they could not have foreseen that “religious terrorism” would be the cause of its closure. Twenty-years ago their concerns were more political than religious! However, today, 8-years after the events of 9-11, it has become obvious to most missionaries around the globe that they are in the middle of a worldwide “religious” war: Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists against Christians and Jews. And they are beginning to sense that perhaps End-Times Prophecies are being worked out in their lifetimes. Of course, people who have not studied Bible Prophecy, nor attended prophecy conferences such as this one, think all of this is just nonsense!

How Mammonism is changing the face of World Missions!

Nevertheless, globalism and terrorism are not the only threat to World Missions! We’ve learned during the last year that “Mammonism,” the pursuit of worldly riches, can be equally deadly. I’ve taken the liberty of using a variation of the biblical term “mammon” in this presentation to maintain the synergy that I wanted nevertheless, the biblical principle is as applicable today as it was back in Jesus’ time.

In Matt. 6 Jesus tells the multitudes that were following Him, *“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, but to lay up treasures in heaven.”* In that context He goes on to say, *“No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.”* **Jesus then went on to describe “mammon” as being those “worldly” things that people worry about: where they will sleep, what they will eat and drink, and the clothing they will wear.** But to the righteous, meaning believers, Jesus says, *“Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be given to you.”*

I don’t know about you, but it certainly seems to me that over the last 8-years both the heathen and God’s people have been pursuing mammon, rather than the Kingdom of God and His righteousness! In fact they have been doing so at such a hectic pace that a huge “housing bubble” was created that could not possibly be sustained.

Yes, there were other factors that contributed to the housing bubble, but you cannot deny that the banks, government agencies, and crooked businessmen did not force the US consumer to go out and buy first and second homes they could not afford! No, people did it willingly and greedily! So when the housing bubble finally burst, as all “excess” bubbles must, they had no one to blame but themselves! **And why? Because Jesus said, they were seeking after mammon and not the Kingdom of God and His righteousness, as Scripture commands!**

And what happens when people violate God’s principles? He allows them to suffer the consequences of their folly, and that is exactly what the world is experiencing right now!

As a result of chasing after mammon many people have:

- Lost homes they could not afford through foreclosure;
- They’ve seen a 40% decline in their 401K Retirement Plans;
- Many lost jobs due to the economic correction that followed; and finally
- Their folly has brought about government intervention in the private sector that is slowly taking away their freedoms to prevent another catastrophe.

Not only have people's lives been greatly affected by their foolishness but, so have many charitable and aid organizations that do a lot of human good locally and around the world. **Equally affected have been many mission organizations and individual missionaries that rely on churches and believers for their existence.** As a result of the reduction in giving brought about by the current economic crisis, many mission organizations are being forced to reduce their staff and curtail their mission activities in order to survive; and many missionary families are being forced to return home due to insufficient support.

The consequences of mankind not living according to God's Plan for their lives have always been suffering and mayhem, as biblical history shows! But what always amazes me when we go through these "boom and bust" cycles, and I'm old enough to have been through a few, is that people are always anxious to go back and do the same things all over again. It's as though they cannot live without the "adrenalin high" they experience while living on the economic edge.

However, the biblical truth is mankind is in rebellion against God and His Plan for their lives, and like Satan they want to be the captains of their own ship! It is not unlike the story of Lot's wife who sadly looked back at Sodom's destruction and as a result was turned into a pillar of salt. Or when the Israelites cried out to return to Egypt after Moses led them safely through the Red Sea. But the best explanation I believe is found in Proverbs 26 where God says, *"As a dog returns to his own vomit, so a fool repeats his folly."*

So despite what Scripture teaches, mankind seems destined to pursue mammon rather than the Kingdom of God and His righteousness! But the consequences of their decision is that they will be held accountable to God for the way they misused the resources and talents He gave them for the purpose of furthering His Kingdom on earth. And if our present economic crisis is any indication, there will be many, many sad people on that judgment day! **In the meantime, however, they will also suffer the consequences of their actions in this life!**

How Socialism Will Change the Face of World Missions

One thing we've learned from the current economic crisis is that man's folly has its "unintended" consequences. I doubt if anyone a year ago would have predicted that the housing boom everyone enjoyed for 7-years would be the "straw that broke the camel's back" and almost brought down our entire financial system. So many economic axioms were violated during the creation of this financial crisis, by people who should have known better, that the outcome of our Government's effort to save the US economy from collapse, still remains in doubt!

The good intentions of government legislators and regulators, who lacked sufficient knowledge about the new debt instruments in today's financial marketplace, certainly contributed to the calamity. And their attempts to solve the crisis, they were elected or hired to prevent, have been equally debatable. Acting on the basis that a "imminent global crisis" existed, those same government officials violated long established laws that historically governed our financial markets, especially the rights of stockholders and bondholders, without due legal process.

The result has been that the Federal Government now owns a majority interest in many large US corporations and is dictating how these companies are to be run and how much money they can pay their employees. **This is unprecedented behavior in our nation's history and will also have its unintended consequences in the future!**

Trillions of Dollars are being printed and spent by our government to prop-up failing banks, insolvent brokerage firms, insurance, automobile, and other companies deemed **“to big to fail,”** thereby insinuating itself into private sector affairs contrary to our country’s principles of “separation of State” in the affairs of its citizens guaranteed by the US Constitution and Bill of Rights. These actions by our appointed officials and elected Representatives have moved our nation away from the Constitutional principles that have been the foundation of our free, democratic system, and that have made our country unique and great!

Many concerned Americans now believe that this Administration is seeking to take the US down the road to Socialism, the effect of which will be that the Federal Government will assume a greater role in determining all aspects of our nation’s economy and in the lives of its citizens. Their intention is for Government officials to determine the priorities of our nation and not its citizens. The result will be that these officials and their political parties will soon be determining what business produces, the prices they can charge, and how much employees are paid. This is completely contrary to what our nation’s Founding Fathers intended when they established our Constitution and Bill of Rights. This movement of governmental control over all aspects of our lives will lead to “totalitarianism,” similar to Hitler’s Germany and Stalin’s Russia, and eventually lead to the total destruction of our “free market system” that has made the standard of living in the US the highest in the world!

But that is not all it will do! A socialist form of government that seeks to control every aspect of our way of life will also seek to limit the private sector’s involvement in community activities currently performed by religious and charitable organizations. Presently these tax-exempt organizations raise funds in the private sector to sponsor many worthwhile social and religious activities in just about every community in the US and in many nations around the world. The thinking is that any government that seeks to control **all** the affairs of its people will not allow its private sector, through special tax incentives, to redirect funds and finance activities that it does not deem to be in the best interest of “all the people.”

Consequently, Christians should expect that any activity sponsored by a religious or charitable organization that is deemed by some Government Czar to be for the benefit of “some” and not “all” the people will eventually be prohibited! A government that controls the “purse strings” of the nation also controls how it gets spent. Socialism in the US will eventually lead to the end of all religious and charitable organizations, as we know them today!

These should be very sobering thoughts to all of us here today! Think for a moment of all the religious and charitable organizations that you know of or personally support that serve a very important role in your community and do so much good around the world, and then imagine the consequences if they no longer existed. Perhaps some people you know will argue that would be a good thing because such activities ought to be controlled by a local or national government, and not by private entities financed by funds that would have been paid into local or federal governments in the form of taxes. Be wary of those who argue from that perspective because they have ulterior motives for their point of view. They favor a political system whereby the Federal Government controls all human activity because of the power it gives to those in positions of authority, positions they hope one day to occupy!

The history of socialized, totalitarian governments has proven that they cannot operate private enterprises efficiently or profitably, nor can they determine how the resources of our nation should best be used for the benefit of its people. Every nation in the world that has tried a socialist or totalitarian form of government has failed miserably, and at its citizens’ expense. And if the US proceeds in that direction it will fail also, because when governments remove all

incentives for its citizens to do those things that are in their “best interest” and to do them as efficiently and economically as possible, total financial ruin results. East Germany was a perfect example of this principle. **History has already proven that the only way for a totalitarian government to exist is to enslave its people!**

Conclusion

Friends the fact that you are attending this Prophecy Conference is sufficient proof for me to conclude that you are Christians who believe in a literal interpretation of the Bible. As you have heard many times during the course of this Conference, there is coming a day when a man, empowered by Satan, will appear on the political scene and during a crisis will seek to take control of all the world’s governments by deceit and cunning. The Bible refers to him as the Antichrist!

That being the case, should we then be surprised by the events of the past 9-months? We shouldn’t be because Scripture reveals how the End will come about! Personally I believe the US is under attack by satanic forces to destroy the world’s greatest example of a free and democratic nation, and that also happens to be the strongest military power in the world? Many of us have been praying and waiting so long for the Rapture of the Church and the fulfillment of End-Times prophecy that we now find it hard to believe those events may soon be upon us! Although we know the “end of the story,” we can’t quite bring ourselves to accept the idea that our Lord’s appearing “in the clouds” and our being called into His presence could be imminent!

That being the case, what sort of people ought we to be when He finally makes His appearance? Rather than storing up riches in this life (mammon), as many are seeking to do again despite their recent experience, I think God’s people would want the Lord to find them pursuing His Kingdom and His Righteousness, just as He commanded. **And this I believe was laid out for us in Matt. 28:18-20 and Acts 1:8!**

We at Radio New Hope are committed to “evangelizing the lost” by proclaiming the Word of God throughout the “whole world” over satellite and the Internet from our broadcast facilities in Zurich, Switzerland until the Lord calls us home. And we are vigorously pursuing that vision by expanding the RNH Satellite Radio Network to include **India and Russia**. This approach to, or concept of World Missions is the “new paradigm” that I was describing at the outset of this talk.

But as long as Christians allow themselves to be caught up in the pursuit of mammon, like unbelievers are doing, then God cannot use them to accomplish His Plan of Salvation for the world! That doesn’t mean His Plan will be thwarted, but it does mean they will lose the blessing He has planned for them when they pursue His Kingdom and His Righteousness until He returns! **As for my wife and I, we want to be able to stand before our Savior and hear His Commendation, “Well done my good and faithful servants,” and I hope you do also!**
